Born October 12, 1946 in Orel Region (Russia). Graduated from the Kursk Agricultural Institute (1971). Doctor (PhD, DSc) of biological sciences (1993), professor (1995), academician of the Russian Academy of Agricultural Science (2007), full member of Russian Academy of Science. Expert in feeding agricultural animals and feed technologies. Junior (1975-1977), senior (1978-1983) researcher, Head of Laboratory of fodder control (1984-1988), Head of Feeding Department (1989-1993); Deputy Director for Research (since 1994) at All-Russian Research and Technological Institute of Poultry.

Qualification: feeding and fodder in poultry, fodder production, common and unconventional fodder resources.

One of the developers of effective plant and unconventional fodder application technology. Co-author of technology of increasing productivity due to use of low protein mixed fodder; a developer of feeding norms and fodder composition in poultry, and recommendations for the use of active substances and feed additives.

Awarded the medal of the Order of Merit for the Motherland of II degree (2007), gold and silver medals of Russian Exhibitions.
