Born January 24, 1950 in the Ryazan Region. Graduated from the Moscow Technological Institute of Meat and Dairy Industry (now the Moscow State University of Applied Biotechnology) (1972). Doctor (PhD, DSc) of veterinary medicine (1992), professor (1995), academician of the Russian Academy of Agricultural Sciences (2001), full member of the Russian Academy of Science (2013). Prominent scientist in the veterinary microbiology and epizootiology. Junior (1973-1981), senior (1981-1988) researcher, Head of Laboratory (1988-1990), Deputy Director (1990), Director (since 1990) of All-Russian State Institute for Control, Standardization and Certification of Veterinary Preparations (All-Russian Center for Control and Standardization of Medicines for Animals).

One of the authors of vaccines against animal leptospirosis, streptococcosis, mycosis, as well as 8 probiotics

More than 450 scientific publications, including 3 monographs (h = 7), 50 patents for inventions.
